

OUMC FACILITIES REVIEW FORM - KDO

SUMMARY

1	On a scale from 1-10, with 1 being worst and 10 being best, how would you rate our KDO facilities? buildings? ministry environments? furnishings?	The overall rating for our KDO Facility averaged 7.7, with a high of 10, and a low of 1, with 10 being the most frequent response. 4 10s, 2 7s and a scattering of others. This suggests that there are a variety of opinions, and that some things need to be addressed, but that the overall opinion of the ministry is very good.
2	On a scale from 1-10, with 1 being worst and 10 being best, how would you rate our KDO ministry environments?	The KDO ministry environments were ranked high overall, at 8.3 on average, with a high of 10, and a low of 2 in the respondent's ratings. 10 was the most frequent answer. Impressions of the KDO environment are very good, with a few exceptions.
3	On a scale from 1-10, with 1 being worst and 10 being best, how would you rate our KDO furnishings?	The KDO ministry furnishings were rated a little lower than the environment was, coming in at an average rating of 7.7. The high rating was 10, and the low 2. Some of the middle and lower ratings here indicate there is some work to do in the area of our KDO furnishings.
4	What specific improvements would you like to see made to our KDO facilities at OUMC?	Place children's items at lower level, new paint and cabinets, toys and craft supplies, learning centers set up. None...it is always clean, fresh, and inviting! More secured storage space, some furniture replaced and updated. Because the rooms are used constantly by so many different groups there is limited visibility that KDO even exists to people new to the church! There is nothing designated as KDO on the rooms. The signs at the doors designate Sunday School rooms so that is confusing to KDO Parents coming in for the first time. More available rooms for more classrooms. Trying to get my 2yo in the program but it's full! A shaded area on playground. At least 1 interactive white board. More space and updated furniture. Windows and light. Ideally, bathrooms in more classrooms, and larger hallways-it gets tight in the hallways during drop off and dismissal. I think the facilities are very clean, well utilized and well loved. Love the new bathroom.
5	If money were no object, what facilities related improvements would you like to see made to our KDO facilities at OUMC? Buildings and/or furnishings/equipment.	New Childcare/KDO Center. More classrooms to grow the program and offer more days for KDO. It would be very nice to have rooms that are KDO only that have at least one window in them. It would be great to be able offer a 3 days per week program. I would love to see a KDO designated eating area with tables and chairs designed for young children rather than having the 4 year olds having to sit at the tall rectangular tables on the adult folding chairs. Bigger Playground area with shade trees. A new children's/youth area with ample storage and larger classrooms. Build a new children's wing. Covered playgrounds outside. Fresh Mulch outside. More classroom bathrooms. Think it's well organized and more importantly the staff (all) are incredibly friendly, knowledgeable, and communicate with parents. More buildings add an elementary school! Maybe more space would allow for a program that is more 3 days a week - more preschool like?

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6 What other thoughts would you like to share on how we could improve our KDO facilities here at OUMC?	The program should be so much more. Yoga, Spanish, music, regular programs and should financially pay for children's director and itself. I think that we have a terrific program to offer to the community. Most of the KDO students do not attend church here so it is actually a good outreach program. It would be nice to be able to grow the program to have even more impact on the community. Pick up line as well as a drop off line. I think KDO is a good steward of available resources at this time and provides a needed service in our community. Possible year round programs. Maybe organizational bins for the shelves, an easier toddler table, it's a little difficult to get children in and out. Doing a wonderful job! For a 2 day a week program I think the facilities are great. The kids have space to move/run/play inside and out. The bathroom improvements made in 2017 are really nice.
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
